## Date of the 1stday

#### 7<sup>th</sup> October 2021

Moderators Jasmina Kamberović and Elvira Hadžiahmetović Jurida opened the round table and presented the goals and purpose of the round table, which were enhance cooperation between teaching staff, students, stakeholders and local community in water monitoring and water protection.

Introductory remarks were given by representatives of the University of Tuzla, vice rector prof. Vesna Bratovčić and Dean of the Faculty of natural sciences and mathematics, prof. Vedad Pašić, especially referring to the results of the launching of the new EMAB master program at UNTZ. Representatives of the Ministry of Education and Science Fuad Mešanović emphasized the support of the Ministry in launching the new master's program.

Review of the studies on aquatic ecosystems at the University of Tuzla was presented by university professors (prof. Avdul Adrović, prof. Isat Skenderović, prof. Semir Ahmetbegović, prof. Jasmina Kamberović and prof. Elvira Hadžiahmetović Jurida) with the aim of setting the initial topic for what purpose the scientific results are used in water management in Tuzla Canton. The success of achieving a multidisciplinary approach in the EMAB master's program and opportunities for even better cooperation within and outside the faculty are emphasized in their addressed.

Activities of the Ministry of agriculture, forestry and water management were presented by the deputy minister Elvira Salihović. She spoke about the past and current projects of this ministry, which were mostly focused on flood protection and water management in Tuzla canton. She emphasizes the willingness of the ministries to cooperate with other sectors in applications for future projects. Deputy minister of the Ministry of spatial planning and environmental protection in Tuzla Canton, Goran Mišić spoke about current project and initiatives for the improvement of water quality in the large Modrac reservoir, which is extremely important for the economy and water supply of the entire Canton nad Bosnia and Herzegovina. There was an open discussion about the necessity of protecting Lake Modrac and preventing pollution. Mayors of the municipalities of Lukavac and Živinice (Edin Delić and Samir Kamenjaković) pointed out the problem of wastewater treatment, which has not yet been regulated in several minicipalies in the Tuzla Canton. For the necessity of purifying wastewaters that flows directly into the lake Modrac, Edin Delić proposes the development of joint applications for the construction of artificial wetlands.

Representatives of the public sector from the water company Vodoprivreda Spreča pointed out the problems of reducing the volume of water in the lake, with the deteriorating water condition, and stressed the need for a systemic solution of the problem. Several approaches have been discussed, among which is the current initiative on the need to desilt the lake. Professor Marko Miliša (UNIZG) presented how similar problems with large reservoirs in neighbouring Croatia are solved, which include periodic drying and cleaning of sludge. Bearing in mind that after purification process, lake Modrac is used to supply the city of Lukavac and Tuzla with drinking water, a discussion was opened on the need to monitor eutrophication and the problems of potential bloom of cyanobacteria and the development of cyanotoxins. It was concluded that monitoring of cyanotoxins is not an integral part of the analyses in the Tuzla canton and that due to potential problems it should be included in the precautionary measures in the analyses bearing in mind the specificity of the water supply of the city of Tuzla. This discussion was initiated by the NGO sector (Centar za ekologiju i energiju) who presented the results of their research on the high content of heavy metals in water and fish tissues in the lake. Representative of the Mining Institute Tuzla, Jasmina Isabegović explained the role of quality monitoring of mining facilities wastewaters for reduction of heavy metals pollution.

Representative of the Ministry of spatial planning and environmental protection gave the initiative to convene a conference on the topic of pollution of Lake Modrac and the Spreča River, inviting all key institutions, with the aim of starting to solve the problem of excessive pollution of this surface waters.



At the end, the students of the newly launched master's program addressed the participants with a vision of how quality monitoring and cooperation can contribute to a better state of the environment.

#### **CONCLUSIONS**

The round table Enhancement of Cooperation Between HEIs and the Real Sector in the Field of Management and Monitoring of Aquatic Resources brought together important target groups: staheholders, professors, students, public sector, local communities. A discussion was opened on the important topics of improvement the quality of Lake Modrac and ver polluted Spreča River, also the need for mutual cooperation between institutions and the need to achieve better results with a multidisciplinary approach and exchange of knowledge. The students of the new master's program were recognized as essential participants in further action. Ideas were proposed for the creation of joint applications in the field of wastewater treatment and encouraging research of the quality of surface water. Potential dangers for the health of residents due to poor water quality were highlighted, which implied the direction of research in future scientific research projects. Students of the new EMAB master's program are recognized as important participants in further activities in water monitoring.




